Social Welfare and Women Empowerment Department – Anganwadi Services – Permission and sanction of expenditure towards carryout annual maintenance activities in the Anganwadi centres for the year 2022-2023 – Granted - Orders – Issued.

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ORDER:-

In accordance with the Government of India's guidelines and schematic norms, the Government, in the Government Order first read above have issued orders, among other things, sanctioning a sum of Rs.12,96,42,000/- towards annual maintenance of Anganwadi centres at the rate of Rs.3000/- per Anganwadi centre to 43,214 Anganwadi centres functioning in Government owned buildings for the year 2021-2022.

2. In the letter second read above, the Government of India in the Annual Programme Implementation Plan (APIP) for the year 2022-2023 has approved a sum of Rs.7,55,80,000/- as its 60% share at the rate of Rs.3,000 per annum per Anganwadi centre for the maintenance of Anganwadi centres functioning in Government owned buildings for the year 2022-2023.

3. In the letter third read above, the Director cum Mission Director, Integrated Child Development Services has stated that the annual maintenance activities has to be carried out at the rate of Rs.3,000/- per Anganwadi centre functioning in Government owned buildings during the year 2022-2023 as detailed below:-

- a) Minor modifications to the centre building – partition board/curtains to ensure privacy during Ante Natal Counselling, repair of water supply system, installation of bulbs, replacement of name board of Anganwadi centre (or) repainting the name and other details of the Anganwadi centre on the outer wall of the building, replacement of water filter candles/cooker gasket/whistle, minor repair works to the Gas stove, replacement of gas tube, korai mats, mosquito nets, minor repair

works to toilets including replacement of water taps, pipes etc., cleaning materials, small containers for keeping the sample food/egg etc., and other essential utensils, purchase of locks to Anganwadi centre etc., which can be done locally on the need basis during the year 2022-2023.

- b) For undertaking minor masonry, carpentry, plumbing and electrical and other related works to maintain the Anganwadi centre building in good condition.
- c) Formation of herbal garden, kitchen garden, other gardening works including the cleaning of surroundings of the Anganwadi centre, fencing the Anganwadi centre wherever needed for ambient atmosphere in premises.
- d) Repair / operationalising soak pits. Erection of half door in the centre, carry out other works needed for better functioning of Anganwadi centres.

4. The Director cum Mission Director, Integrated Child Development Services has requested to sanction a sum of Rs.12,59,67,000/- in the sharing pattern of 60:40 between the Central Government and State Government towards carry out annual maintenance activities at the rate of Rs.3,000/- per Anganwadi centre in 41,989 Anganwadi centres functioning in Government owned buildings for the year 2022-2023 and to permit to park the above said amount into the Single Nodal Agency account of General ICDS and also to incur the above said expenditure for the above activities.

5. After careful examination of the request of the Director cum Mission Director, Integrated Child Development Services, the Government issue orders as follows:-

- I. Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.12,59,67,000/- (Rupees Twelve crore fifty nine lakh and sixty seven thousand only) with the sharing pattern of 60:40 between the Central Government and State Government (60% of Government of India share being Rs.7,55,80,200/- and 40% State Government share being Rs.5,03,86,800/-) at the rate of Rs.3,000 per Anganwadi centre towards carry out the annual maintenance activities as mentioned in paragraph-3 above in 41,989 Anganwadi centres functioning in Government owned buildings as detailed in the Annexure to this order during the year 2022-2023 subject to the condition that the Government of India guidelines should be followed scrupulously.
- II. The District Programme Officers concerned are directed to get the details of works to be carried out in each Anganwadi centre and issue in principal sanction.
- III. The Director cum Mission Director, Integrated Child Development Services is permitted to make inter-district transfer of funds based on the actual need/requirement if necessary within the overall financial allocation.
- IV. The Director cum Mission Director, Integrated Child Development Services is permitted to authorize the District Programme Officers / Child Development Project Officers concerned to draw and disburse the amount and incur the above expenditure under annual maintenance grant.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in paragraph-5(l) above shall be debited under the following heads of account:-
